ADDENDUM_I

to the

AGREEMENT ON PRIVILEGES, EXEMPTIONS, AND IMMUNITIES

Reference is made to the "Agreement on Privileges, Exemptions, and Immunities" between the American Institute in Taiwan and the Coordination Council for North American Affairs, entered into on October 2, 1980 pursuant to Section 10 (c) of the Taiwan Relations Act (Public Law 96-8--April 10, 1979), hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement."

The parties to the Agreement hereby affirm that at the time of implementation of the Agreement it was understood that wherever appearing throughout the Agreement the phrase "jurisdiction in which the receiving counterpart organization is located* referred to the United States or Taiwan, that "central ... authorities" referred to the United States federal government or its equivalent on Taiwan, and that "local authorities" referred to state, provincial, county, city, and other forms of municipal government. This remains the common interpretation by both parties of the aforementioned language of the Agreement.
