The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) presently has a Rapid Prototyping System (RPS) Manual and RPS Executable Software (PC version) on loan to the American Institute in Taiwan for use by the Civil Aeronautics Administration (CAA) of Taiwan under the enclosed Memorandum of Agreement NAT-I-845-5, which expired on November 29, 1995.


This equipment is now surplus to the needs of the FAA and is thus considered foreign excess property. The FAA, which is authorized by law to donate foreign excess property which has no commercial value, has declared its willingness to donate this equipment for use by the CAA.
